







In the Russian-occupied territories, Ukrainian citizens are being persecuted for participating in protests, criticizing the occupying administrations, having human rights aspirations, expressing religious views or simply wearing clothes of blue and yellow colours.

As of 22 August 2024, the Mission of the President of Ukraine in the Autonomous Republic of Crimea/Office of the Crimea Platform thereafter - the Mission is aware about currently, there are 219 Crimean political prisoners, in particular 133 of them are Crimean Tatars, the indigenous people of Ukraine. Each of them political prisoners continues to support Ukraine and the democratic world even in the inhumane conditions of Russian penitentiary facilities.

We suggest you to show your support and solidarity for political prisoners in the following ways:

- To write a letter to a political prisoner and join "Letter to Free Crimea" campaign.
- To become a mentor to a political prisoner.

LETTERS TO FREE CRIMEA

Why: The initiative aims at drawing attention to Ukrainian prisoners of the Kremlin. These letters are an important message to Russian and occupation prison administrations that the international community is aware of these people and is closely monitoring their condition.

How: Support them with a word, a joke, a news story, a conversation or educational materials.

- Letters undergo censorship in Russian prisons and have to be written in Russian language, otherwise they will not be handed over to the addressees
- Keep your letters politically neutral and refrain from asking questions about criminal cases.
- Do not write addressee that could compromise you or the recipient.
- There are no restrictions on the amount of text in letters or their format.
